

Easy Slay-On Bib

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Bibs are great for keeping baby's outfit clean, but getting them on and then getting them to stay put can be something of a challenge.

This simple little bib is a quick and easy knit, and is designed to slip over the head without any ties, toggles or buttons to fuss with.

DIFFICULTY

Easy - techniques used: knitting in the round, decreasing

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 7.25 inches wide by 8.5 inches long

MATERIALS

Lily Sugar'n Cream Ombres & Prints [100% cotton; 95yds/87m per 2oz/57g skein]; colour: Playtime, 02741; 1 skein

1 16" circular US 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needle

1 pair US 7 (4.5 mm) needles

GAUGE

16 sts/24 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

K knit

k2tog knit 2 together

kwise knitwise (as if to knit)
pwise purlwise (as if to purl)

P purlSI slip

ssk slip, slip, knit

st(s) stitchesWS wrong side

Bib

With the circular needle, cast on 60 sts and join in the round, being careful not to twist.

Work in double rib for about 1.5 inches as follows: *K2, P2. Repeat from * all around.

Next row: Bind off 28, K to end of round.

Turn; work back and forth in rows for the remainder of bib. Switch to straight needles.

Next row (WS): SI first stitch pwise, K2, P to last 3 sts, K2, P1.

Next row (RS): SI first st kwise, K to end.

Repeat these two rows until piece measures 7.5 inches from edge, ending with WS row.

Next row: SI first st kwise, K2, ssk, K to last 5 stitches, k2tog, K3. (30 stitches)

Next row: SI first st pwise, K2, purl to last 3 sts, K2, P1.

Next row: SI first st kwise, K2, ssk, K to last 5 sts, k2tog, K3. (28 stitches)

Next row: SI first st pwise, K2, ssk, K to last 5 sts, k2tog, K2, P1. (26 stitches)

Next row: SI first st kwise, K2, ssk, K to last 5 sts, k2tog, K3. (24 stitches)

Next row: SI first st pwise, K2, ssk, K to last 5 sts, k2tog, K2, P1. (22 stitches)

Bind off all sts. Weave in ends and block.
